

MyHotspotter for EeePC Installation Guide

This document contains a basic installation guide (pages 1-2) as well as an advanced installation using the "apt-get" tool (pages 3-5) for expert users who may prefer using this method instead.

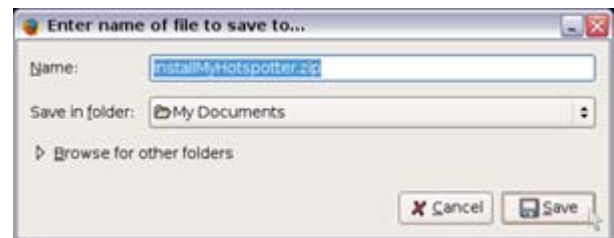
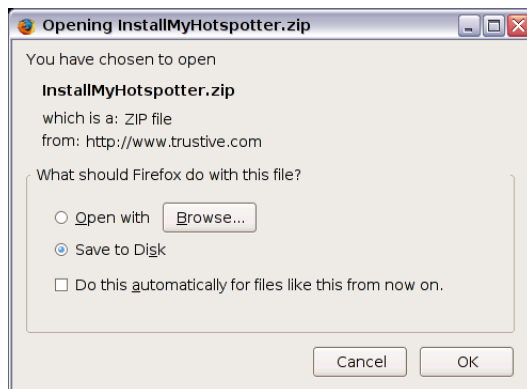
BASIC INSTALLATION GUIDE

1) Download the MyHotspotter for EeePC installation file

Download MyHotspotter for EeePC by going to <http://www.trustive.com/myhotspotter/eeepc/download> or by clicking on the corresponding download link on www.trustive.com.

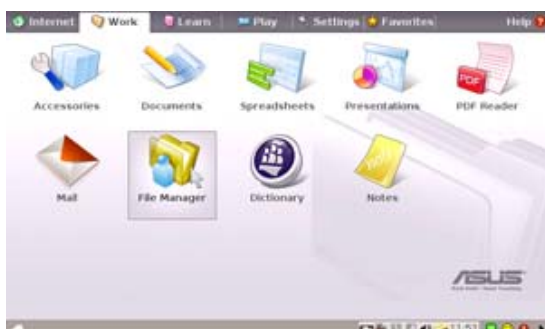
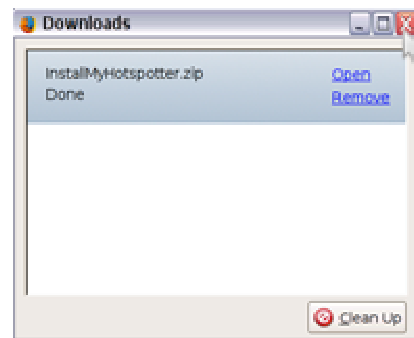
2.) Save the MyHotspotter installation file

When prompted, choose to save the install file to your disk and then save it in your 'My Documents' folder or anywhere else you choose to.



3) Close the download window

Once the download is complete, do NOT click on open or remove in the download window, simply close this window, by clicking the red "X" on the top-right corner



4) Open your file manager

In your EeePC Work tab, open the file manager.

5) Open the installation zip file

Locate the MyHotspotter installation zip file that you downloaded (InstallMyHotspotter.zip) and double click on it to open it.

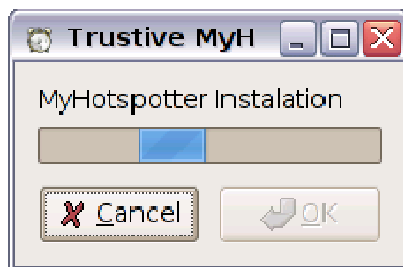
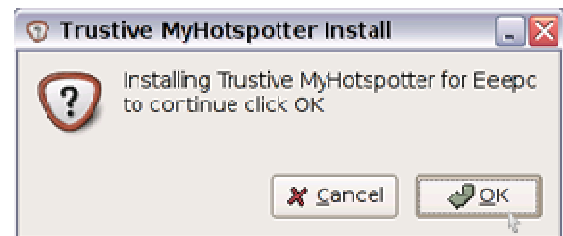


6) Launch the installation

Once the installation zip file is open, double click on the installation command file: InstallMyHotspotter.sh

7) Confirm the installation

When prompted, click on OK to begin the installation process.

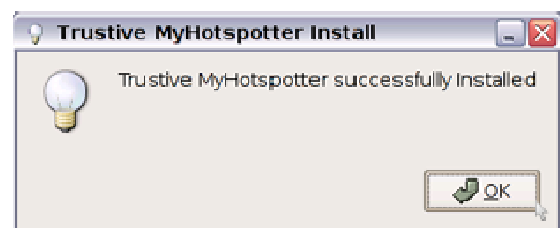


8) Installation ongoing

Wait for the installation to finish.

9) Installation completed

A pop up window will inform you when the installation process has been successfully completed. Click OK.

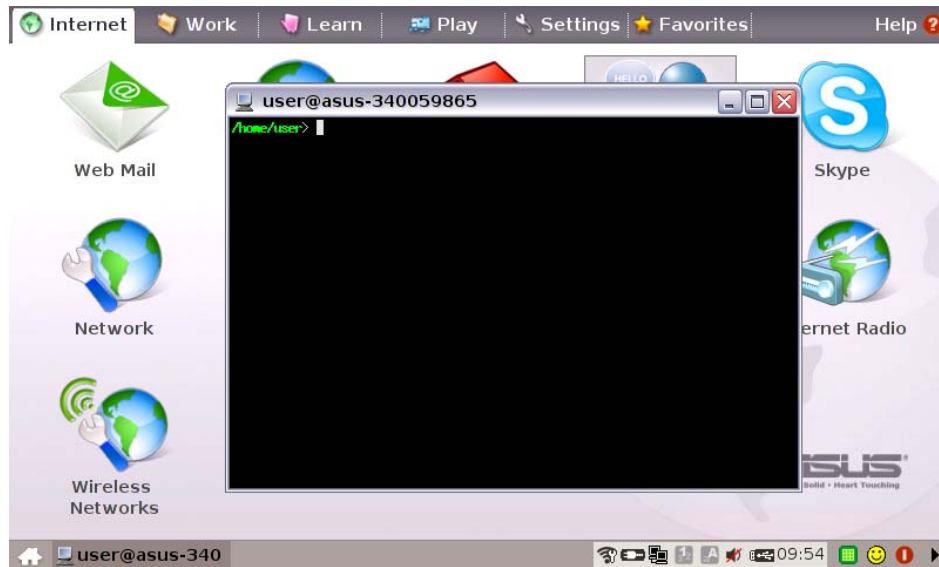


10) Start MyHotspotter

To launch MyHotspotter, click on the "T" icon in your EeePC Internet tab

ADVANCED INSTALLATION GUIDE USING APT-GET TOOL

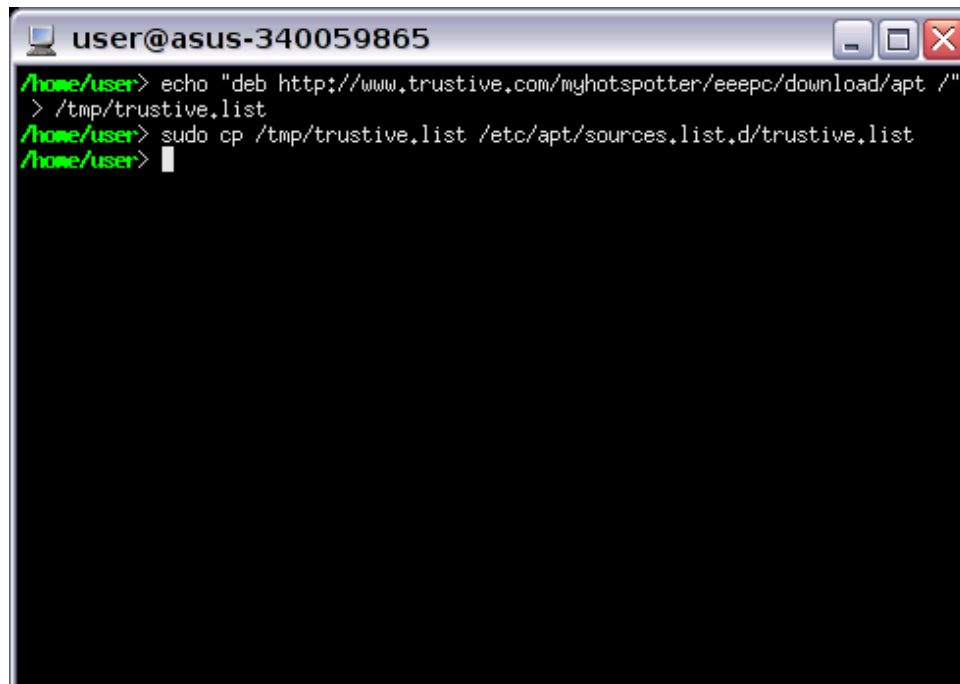
1) Start Terminal session: CTRL + ALT + T



2) Add Trustive to apt-get repository

Copy the following 2 commands into the terminal:

```
echo "deb http://www.trustive.com/myhotspotter/eeepc/download/apt/" > /tmp/trustive.list  
sudo cp /tmp/trustive.list /etc/apt/sources.list.d/trustive.list
```



5) Install MyHotspotter

Copy the following line into the terminal: `sudo apt-get install myhotspotter`
